Title of Bill: Police Surveillance Vehicle

1 **Section I. Body:** due to recent incidents of police involved shootings, officers will be
2 required to have surveillance cameras on their vehicles powered on at all times.

4 **Be It Enacted By The American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State 2016**

5 **Section II. Definitions:** Surveillance is a recording of both sound and visuals. The
6 cameras will be able to survey are around the entire police vehicle. Incidents are
7 events occurring between civilian and civilian or civilian and officer.

8 **Section III. Penalty:** when officers clock in, they will be required to have vehicle
9 surveillance on at all times. If the officers fail to comply, will get a warning and a fine of
10 \$200.00, if a second offence is made will be forced to face desk duty for a month in
11 addition to \$200.00 fine. If a third offence is make the officer will be required to turn in
12 their badge.

13 **Section IV. Repeal:** All laws, acts, provisions, or parts of laws contained in the
14 constitution of the State of New Mexico in conflict with any provision of this act are
15 hereby repealed.

17 **Section V. Effective Date:** the provisions of this act shall be effective on and after July
18 17, 2016. This act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval
19 by the American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State governor or its otherwise
20 becoming a law.
