Title of Bill: Standardized Testing

1 **Section I. Body:** standardized testing conflict with the learning environment of our  
2 school education. Students are not tested to full potential and classrooms are centered  
3 on these tests.

4 **Be It Enacted By The American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State 2016**

5 **Section II. Definitions:** standardized testing is a test organized by the government,  
6 state or federal to measure a student's educational progress and reflects on school or  
7 state educational ratings.

8 **Section III. Penalty:** standardized tests should be abolished or reformed. If reformed  
9 tests should consist less than 10% of school ranking. School ranking should instead be  
10 evaluated on less than 25% on whether students have a successful, steady, careers  
11 after fifteen (15) years after graduating.

14 **Section IV. Repeal:** all laws, acts, provisions, or parts of laws contained in the  
15 constitution of the State of New Mexico in conflict with any provision of this act are  
16 hereby repealed.

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18 **Section V. Effective Date:** the provisions of this act shall be effective on and after  
19 August 21, 2030.
