Title of Bill: Common Core Standards

1 **Section I. Body:** New Mexico schools will teach Common Core curriculum and test on
2 Common Core like other states. By teaching Common Core, students who have moved
3 from different states or a different part of New Mexico will not be penalized or fall behind
4 because of the different schooling standards. This is an issue because families that
5 move frequently, like military families, often have to retake classes or take extra classes
6 because of the states/schools requirements.

7 **Be It Enacted By The American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State 2016**

8 **Section II. Definitions:** penalized – put in an unfavorable position or at an unfair
9 disadvantage. Common Core Curriculum the standardized curriculum as defined by the
10 Federal Government.

11 WHEREAS: the tests are verbatim thus creating a standardized letter grade for the
12 class.

13 **Section III. Penalty:** New Mexico will change their teachings to Common Core like
14 many other state, so new incoming student who have moved are not at a disadvantage.

15 **Section IV. Repeal:** All laws, acts, provisions, or parts of laws contained in the
16 constitution of the State of New Mexico in conflict with any provision of this act are
17 hereby repealed.

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19 **Section V. Effective Date:** the provisions of this act shall be effective on and after
20 August 1, 2017.
