Title of Bill: Amber Alert for Adults and Senior Citizens

1 **Be It Enacted By The American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State 2016**

3 Section I. Body: Adults 20 years and older and senior citizens 50 years and
4 older who go missing two days or more deserve an Amber Alert issued
5 statewide

6 (New Mexico) to notify citizens of their disappearance. Adults and senior
7 citizens who are noble individuals who go missing do not receive any urgency
8 from authorities and are highly missed by their immediate families.

9 Section II. Definitions:

10 Amber Alert - A widely publicized bulletin that alerts the public to a
11 recently abducted or missing child

12 noble - having, showing, or coming from personal qualities that people admire
13 such as honesty, generosity, courage, etc.

14 Section III. Penalty: A type of Amber Alert issued statewide or to
15 neighboring states to notify citizens of a missing adult 20 years and older
16 and a senior citizen 50 years and older.

17 Section IV. Repeal: All laws, acts, provisions, or parts of laws contained in
18 the Constitution of the State of New Mexico in conflict with any provision of
19 this act are hereby repealed.

20 Section V. Effective Date: The provisions of this act shall be effective on
21 and after November, 1st, 2017.
