Title of Bill: Standardized Testing

A Resolution

Section I. Body: students across New Mexico are required to take the PARCC, Science SBA, EOC exams and finals. Each type of test takes a least a week to complete. They take away time from classes to prepare and to take them.

Therefore be it Resolved By The American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State 2016 that:

Section II. Definitions: PARCC (Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers): Test over English language arts, literacy, and mathematics.

Section III. Penalty: having a combined version of the PARCC, SBA, and the addition of the social studies section would cut down the amount of testing time. The combined version would take from a week to a week and half. Finals are required in every class a student is taking.

Section IV Repeal: all laws, acts, provisions, or parts of laws contained in the Constitution of the State of New Mexico in conflict with any provision of this act are hereby repealed.

Section V. Effective Date: the provision of this act shall be effective on and after November 30, 2016.
