Be It Enacted By The American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State 2016

Section I. Body: Relating to the current graduation requirements in the state of New Mexico include credit requirements and proving competency in all five core subject areas through pass/fail of PARCC assessments and End Of Course exams. Whereas the assessments and exams prove competency, both should not be required to graduate high school. Whereas school districts should have the ability to chose to administer either PARCC assessments or End Of Course exams. Should students fail the assessment chosen, they be required to perform alternative competency requirement mandated by the school district.
