Title of Bill: Educational Spending Act of 2016

1 **Be It Enacted By The American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State 2016**

3 **Section I. Body:** An increase in educational spending will accommodate the
4 high drop out rates and the shortage of teachers, as well as introduce new
5 fields of study and improve necessary equipment. Schools must prepare and
6 submit their proposed budget for the next educational year to the New Mexico
7 government for review and approval. Every school district needs to spend the
8 allocated budget within the sanctioned educational year on specified fields
9 of study in addition to submitting periodical reports on spending to the New
10 Mexican government in the provided, specified format.

7 **Section II. Definitions:**

8 As used in the "Educational Spending Act of 2016"

9 A. "New fields of study" - the new types of subjects in school.

10 B. "Educational year" - August to July

11 C. "Necessary equipment" - Sport equipment such as balls, bats, nets, etc.
12 School equipment such as calculators, books, desks, etc.

13 **Section III. Penalty:** The school district must repay the amount spent on
14 non-specified items. Remaining budget will be revoked if periodical reports
15 are not submitted. Educational spending will be monitored by the New Mexican
16 government.

17 **Section IV. Repeal:** All laws, acts, provisions, or parts of laws contained in
18 the Constitution of the State of New Mexico in conflict with any provision of
19 this act are hereby repealed.

20 **Section V. Effective Date:** The provisions of this act shall be effective on
21 and after August 1, 2016.
