Title of Bill: Body Integrity Act

1 **Section I. Body:** Relating to microchip implants and tracking devices and data  
2 collection in which all mandatory implanting of microchips and tracking devices in  
3 humans and the data collection involved shall be prohibited and not parent may have  
4 their child implanted with a microchip and no child may receive a microchip voluntarily  
5 till the age of consent, recognized by the state as eighteen (18) years of age.

6 WHEREAS: the state recognized the inherent right of the citizens to privacy and the  
7 inherent right of protection against both violation of body and the unlawful collection of  
8 data;

9 WHEREAS: prohibition of mandatory microchips and data collection will protect citizens'  
10 rights;

11 WHEREAS: implementing this act shall insure that no man, woman, or child shall be  
12 involuntarily implanted with a microchip or tracking device and data from that device  
13 shall not be collected against the person implemented.

14 **Be It Enacted By The American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State 2016**

15 All mandatory implantation of microchips and tracking devices and the collection of data  
16 involved be prohibited. Implantation of a child with a microchip or tracking device with  
17 parental consent shall be prohibited. No child under the age of eighteen (18) may be  
18 implanted with a microchip or tracking device.

19 **Section II. Definitions:** as used by the Body Integrity Act

20 A. "microchip" being a small piece of semi-conductor material carrying many  
21 integrated circuits and used to transmit data and/or as a means of identification  
22 and implanted in the body.

23 B. "tracking device" is a piece of electronic equipment using a GPS (Global  
24 Positioning System) to transmit data of the wearers' location and is implanted in  
25 the body.

26 **Section III. Penalty: NEEDED**

27 **Section IV. Repeal:** all laws, acts, provisions, or parts of laws contained in the  
28 constitution of the State of New Mexico in conflict with any provision of this act are  
29 hereby repealed.

31 **Section V. Effective Date:** this act shall become effective immediately upon its  
32 passage and approval by the American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State  
33 governor or its otherwise becoming law.
