DEFINITIONS: A. "Natural energy resource" Renewable energy is

any energy source that is naturally replenished, like that

derived from solar, wind, geothermal or hydroelectric action.

Energy produced from the refining of biomass is also often

classified as renewable. Coal, oil or natural gas, on the other

hand, are finite sources

MAIN PROVISIONS:

SECTION 2. IMPLIMENTATION. –

23

WHEREAS, America is rich in natural energy resources, most

1 notably, solar and wind.

2 WHEREAS, As energy demands will continue to inflate, it is  
3 incumbent upon Legislators to be forward thinking in future  
4 energy challenges for the present and following generations of  
5 Americans.

6 THERFORE, it is vital to develop a long-term energy plan  
7 promoting clean and affordable energy technologies.

9 PENALTY:

10 APPROPRIATION:

11 SECTION 3. APPROPRAITION.

12 WHEREAS, The Congress of the United States will mandate and  
13 provide adequate budget from the Department of Energy. Moreover,  
14 this bill shall invest in and seek to encourage institutes of  
15 higher education to conduct research into and attract companies  
16 for the development of future technologies.

18 All laws, acts, provisions, or parts of laws contained in the Constitution of the State of New  
19 Mexico in conflict with any provision of this act are hereby repealed.

21 EFFECTIVE DATE

22 The provisions of this act shall be effective on and after January 1, 2018
