7 FULL TITLE: RELATING TO A PROVISION FOR WORKING INDIVIDUALS WHO
8 HAVE DEPENDENTS; CONTINUING THE PAYMENT FOR A FIVE DAY/FORTY
9 HOUR WEEKLY WORK SCHEDULE FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO LIVE WITH
10 DEPENDENTS WHILE ALLOWING THEM TO WORK A FOUR DAY/THIRTY-TWO
11 HOUR WEEK, WITH THE EMPLOYER PAYING FOR THE ADDITIONAL EIGHT
12 HOURS; PROVIDING SUPPORT TO WORKING INDIVIDUALS WHO NEED
13 ADDITIONAL TIME TO CARE FOR DEPENDENTS/FAMILY MEMBERS WHO
14 REQUIRE DOMESTIC ASSISTANCE WITHIN AND RELATED TO THE HOUSEHOLD.

19 DEFINITIONS:

20 MAIN PROVISIONS: An individual, regardless of gender, supporting
21 dependents within their household, will be granted a thirty two
22 hour work week. The employer of said individual, regardless of
23 size, organization or origin, will provide the employee with the
24 pay and benefits of a forty hour work week. The
25 individual/employee, must provide evidence of having dependents
