This bill primarily has to do with the online world, the internet, and the people that use, and

13

take part in its workings. Many social media platforms have very unfair, biased, and messy

14

policies. Including: private policies, terms of use, and what is allowed on platforms. Rules

15

that are in place for certain people are not put in place for the rest. Popular

1 Youtubers and Streamers are given passes for breaking these rules, when less popular
2 ones don't. They break their own rules, causing these people to "get out of hand"
3 Platforms of focus: YouTube, Twitch, Twitter:
4 Proof and incidents: Logan Paul, Jake Paul, Alinity v Pewdiepie, Background on both
5 "Incidents":
6 Logan Paul: Youtuber with 17 million Subscribers, who went to "Suicide Forest" in Japan,
7 filmed a dead body, began laughing as a "coping mechanism" as labeled by some, left, but
8 continued to act disrespectfully in Japan. Places including temples of worship and on
9 streets and with the locals. These actions were placed to be viewed by his followers, many
10 consisting of young children. Children saw the real corpse of a person who had succumbed
11 to suicide. YouTube rewarded him by placing Logan Paul on the "trending Page" for even
12 more vies and exposure. When other rue-loaded the same video they received a strike for
13 displaying disturbing and violent content. Logan received no such mark.
14 Alinity v Pewdiepie: Alinity, a streamer on Twitch, bragged about misusing the "copy Right
15 Strike" tool that her partner company, CollabDRM had allowed her to use. "I'm gonna copy
16 strike this guy, just for that word,,," Days before, Pewdiepie, a popular Youtuber on
17 YouTube, made a video that included Alinity for mere seconds, than called the women who
18 used their body for money, Twice Thots." Alinity reacted to this video that day after, then
19 said, "I'm gonna copy strike this guy, just for that word,,," Braggin about using her
20 company's power in an unfair way, "They sending me seven hundred dollars last month,
21 from copy strike hitting people. Good money."
22 Companies have creators that display and directly violate their terms of use, yet do nothing
23 solely because they generate money for themselves. Its either all okay, or none of it is
24 okay. Companies need to be punished and taken to court for favoring clien
