AN ACT

Children in Poor Counties Being Left Without Food During Weekends.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY NEW MEXICO GIRLS STATE:

In many areas of our states, there are so many children that don't have food during the weekends or when schools are out for summer vacation. That is why Schools and communities need funding to help feed children that don't have food when they are home. All throughout our state, many families sell their food stamps to buy drugs and

1 end up not being able to feed their children. Or the families make too much so they don't
2 qualify for food stamps. It is sad that so many people qualify for food stamps that don't
3 s=deserve hem, but families that need that help of food stamps don't qualify. So as a state I
4 ask that we help fund the schools in order for our states children to be healthy, no child
5 should starve due to their parents addictions. We cannot let children starve because if they
6 do what type of state will we be. Our children are the future for the whole country. We have
7 to be able to provide food for everyone. Even though we already give out support like food
8 stamps we need to still provide food for all the hungry children. We have to provide as
9 much as we can because as a nation and state, no child or family should be hurting due to
