Title: First 2 Years of College Free Act

Section I. Body: Due to the high tuition rates each year for college, many

who wish to attend cannot afford it. This Bill will allow a student to be enrolled for their first 2 years free of cost; whereas this will lead to higher education; whereas dropout and unemployment rates will decrease as

more people would be able to get their associates degree.

Section II. Definitions: All citizens and residents of the United States of America will be granted the opportunity to be enrolled at a local college of

their preference for 2 years, tuition free. The tax payers of America will be

paying for the student's tuition costs. The student must remain enrolled for

both years, and hold a GPA of a minimum 3.0.

Section III. Penalty: The tuition of a student who maintains a 3.0 GPA will

have their college tuition paid for first 2 years. If the GPA drops below a

3.0 GPA they risk having their free 2 year tuition suspended.

Section IV. Repeal: All laws, acts, provisions, or parts of laws contained in

the Constitution of the State of New Mexico in conflict with any provision of

this act are hereby repealed.

Section V. Effective Date: The provisions of this act shall be effective on

and after January 1st, 2016.
