An Act

Section 1.

New Mexico's booming oil industry has reached its level of maturity using fracking, a process used to retrieve using a pressurized water mixture by replacing the contents of the rock. Oil production is among New Mexico's top 3 economic advancements along with tourism and mining. However, fracking for oil has been implemented near Chaco Canyon, a historical landmark of great importance of New Mexican Culture.

Be It Enacted By The American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State 2015

Section 2.

The outlaw of fracking near historical landmarks and sites in New Mexico to preserve the irreplaceable nature of these locations
"Near" shall be defined as within a 10-mile radius of a historical landmark and biodegradable chemicals

Section 3.

Any company in violation of this law will lose fracking capabilities within New Mexico Borders for a period of 15 years and serve a \$5000 fine that will go towards damage costs.

Section 4.

All laws, acts, provisions, r parts of laws contained in the Constitution of the State of New Mexico in conflict with any provision of this act are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Effective Date:

This act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State.
