SENATE RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION

RELATING TO IMMIGRATION; RELATING TO CREATING SANCTUARY CITIES,
DECREASING THE AMOUNT OF TIME TAKEN TO BE ACCEPTED WHICH MAY
REVISE THE STANDARDS OF APPROVAL; PROVIDING A SERENE PROCESS TO BE
ALLOWED TO COME TO CITIES WITHIN THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO; PROVIDING
LESS LIMITATIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY
NEW MEXICO GIRLS STATE:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS

1 A. "standards" means the mean of being able to be a resident;

2 B. "serene" means a process that is not as difficult;

3 C. "limitations" means the difficult procedure immigrants go through.

4 SECTION 2. Sanctuary Cities

5 Coming to the state of New Mexico should not only have a shorter process but also
6 have a lower cost for the purpose of moral and economic reasons. Unless people are
7 Native New Mexicans, no one is truly the rightful owner of this land. Because most of our
8 ancestors were immigrants and some came to New Mexico for a better way of living, New
9 Mexico should have sanctuary cities and openly accept foreigners (with some restrictions).
10 Restrictions, such as having desirable qualities to work and be an active member of
11 society, will be enforced. Generally, immigrants who come to the state of New Mexico to
12 have an improved manner of living, despite the generalization of people that immigrants are
13 drug dealers and criminals. This resolution will assure that the people who come here to
14 work and benefit the economy have a greater chance of being accepted to come to
15 sanctuary cities in New Mexico. Foreign people can help build up the economy and boost
16 employment. Immigration, contrary to the belief of most New Mexicans, does not lower
17 wages. Foreigners indeed increase supply and demand, are less likely to be involved with
18 crime, and increase wages and income of New Mexicans. The time taken to be accepted to
19 come to sanctuary cities in New Mexico should be shortened to 2 to 6 months to ensure
20 immigrants are not harmed in the situation for which they are coming to New Mexico.

21 22 SECTION 3: PROPOSAL TO CREATE AND MAINTAIN SANCTUARY CITIES IN 23 THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO

24 Within these sanctuary cities be it providing a serene process to be allowed to come

1 to the state of New Mexico; providing less limitations. Whereas this resolution may be
2 instated no later than August 20th, 2019.

4 SECTION 4. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be submitted to the 5
5 people for their approval or rejection at the next general election or at any special election
6 prior to that date that may be called for that purpose.
