**An Act**

Section 1. Body.

Many University do not allow acts of freedom of speech (speaking badly of people, passing out pamphlets with controversial views etc.) except in designated “freedom of speech” areas. This causes a lack of a spread of ideas, corruptions, and/or events that students need to be informed of. Putting this bill into effect would increase the progression of necessary information within the student body.

Section 2. Definitions.

- A. Rules and Regulations: if inappropriate or overly offensive material should still be promoted, rules should still be enforced.
- B. Freedom of Speech: the freedom to say whatever one wishes. (in this case, to an extent) with no punishment.

Section 3. Repeal.

It will no longer b allowed to ban all controversial speech.

Section 4. Effective Date.

The provisions of this act shall be effective July 30, 2015 in preparation for the new school year.
