1 Through the school systems here in New Mexico, students should prepare for the EOC  
2 and the EOY testing throughout their elementary and middle school years in placement of  
3 the New Mexico Based standardized test to prep students for their high school EOC and  
4 EOY testing where it begins to matter the most because at this point the NMSBA is being  
5 substituted for the EOC and EOY which also determines if you graduate or not senior  
year. And there should be no reason to pack more things on high school students to  
believe they are graduating by this mean class of 2019 should officially begin the EOY  
and EOC in high school due to the time they had for study, as for high school students  
who took it, should not be counted against them.

6 Be It Enacted By The American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State 2015  
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8 In place of the standardized test class of 2019 and above should begin to prep for the  
9 EOY as well as the EOC. As for high schooler's of class of 2018 and below should  
continue with the NMSBA.

10 Section 1. Short Title. This act may be cited as the EOC/EOY Preparation Act"

11 Section 2. Definitions. As used in the EOC/EOY preparation Act.

12 A. Students will be more successful in taking the EOC/EOY when it matters most in  
13 high school

14 Section 3. Provisions. This program will be monitored by the state administration as well as school  
districts.

15 A. By Proportions there will be a higher rate of students that will pass the test.

16 B. Of class 2019 and up shall only prepare for the EOY/EOC since in placement of NMSBA

17 C. There will be no senior being held back to graduate.

18 Section 4. Enactment. This bill should go into effect 30 days after passage.  
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
