BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY NEW

MEXICO GIRLS STATE:

1. Creates jobs pertaining to eliminating fire hazards around the city of Cedar. This could

- 1 also be used as a way to combat any homeless issues the city of Cedar may be facing, by
2 opening up more jobs to the homeless.
- 3 2. Eliminate any fire hazards to keep the city of Cedar safe from fires during the drought.
- 4 3. Create economic prosperity through new jobs being created. Creating new jobs creates
5 more consumers, which in turn means more money for the city of Cedar
- 6 4. Help towards any unemployment issues the city of Cedar may be facing.
- 7 5. Help solve the city of Cedar's fire hazard issue during the drought in the most
8 economically feasible way.
- 9 6. Help solve fire hazard issues while using the least amount of water or water sources
10 possible so that the city of Cedar can hold onto as much water and water sources as
11 possible during the drought.
- 12 7. Create a safer environment during the drought in order to help preserve life and wildlife
13 in and around the city, and to also help protect businesses and houses in and around the
14 city of Cedar.
- 15 8. Allow the city of Cedar's Fire Department to have an easier time keeping the city of
16 Cedar safe during the drought by making their jobs easier and allowing to focus on real
17 fires more efficiently.
- 18 9. Allow for fire hazards to be taken care of without the use of water and before the fire
19 hazard may turn into an actual fire.
