| 12 | For many years New Mexico has given continuous effort to compete in the "new space | | | | | |

- have not proven profitable to the state. In 2017 alone, approximately \$5.4 million was
- 2 funded by lawmakers in revenues of New Mexico Spaceport Authority with only 600 tickets
- 3 sold in the past 7 years with no flight to date. The Spaceport has come to rely on tourism to
- 4 meet funding demands, disengaging the sole purpose of Virgin Galactic "commercial flight",
- 5 making the Space port a futuristic attraction rather than a functioning facility for space
- 6 exploration. The mass amounts of money being taken away from taxpayers is also adding
- 7 to the worsening poverty levels of surrounding counties.
- 8 The New Mexico Spaceport does not offer the same optimistic outlook as when it first
- 9 opened. The facility sucks up resources generating \$470,000 of funding annually and then
- furthering their demands of nearly \$2.35 million for "shortfall of revenue". While this may
- sound reasonable, these numbers are crushing to the state of New Mexico, rated one of
- the poorest states nationwide. The state cannot afford to fund a program that does not
- generate an adequate income. The promise of a boosted economy has failed and the
- 14 Spaceport only receives money rather than investing back into the community. With the
- state nearly \$3.6 billion in debt, money must be managed appropriately and wisely, neither
- of which is not being done in the investment of the New Mexico Spaceport.
