**An Act**

Section 1.

Relating to election processes; changing election processes whether by mail or in person; creating standards for voter requirements statewide. Whereas the election process will be less vulnerable to corruption; whereas, as the responsibility of the United States citizen, this responsibility of most import is protected and validated under State Law

**Be It Enacted By The American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State 2015**

Section 2.

- A. "Physical proof of identification" being a State or Federally issued document containing the voter's name and photograph.
- B. "Corruption" being defined as a single citizen voting more than once in order to influence election results, and/or non-citizens casting ballots to influence election results.
- C. "Responsibility of the United States citizen" being voting in any party, city, county, district, state, or national election.

Section 3.

This act would be monitored by the County Clerk.

- A. Physical proof of identification required before receiving or casting a ballot.
- B. Any potential voters without physical proof of identification will not be allowed to receive or cast a ballot until lack of identification is rectified.
- C. For people who are residents of another state but live in New Mexico (i.e. Military) may get a special picture ID saying they are a citizen residing in New Mexico so they can participate in state elections.

25 D. The government would be required to add a picture to the required voter card  
26 as this amendment is passed; whereas adding a photo would allow for all registered  
27 voters to have an ID for required ID during voting process; whereas all already registered  
28 would be required to get a new voter card; whereas all US citizens currently living out of  
29 country and send in a vote will also be required to send in a photocopy of an ID card.

30 Section 4.

31 All Laws, Acts, provisions, or parts of laws contained in the Constitution of the State of  
32 New Mexico in conflict with any provision of this act are hereby repealed

33

34 Section 5.

35 This act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the  
36 American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State Governor or its otherwise becoming a  
37 law.
